Annunciation to Joseph, Anton Raphael Mengs, c. 1767







The Laity from the Catechism




Title: St. Joseph, Light of Patriarchs

St. Joseph:


Three dreams to save his family and the world.



Lessons from 'the Josephs' as prophet

- Saving your family IS saving the world
- •Faith in God's word even though all evidence seems to be to the contrary
- Faithfulness despite great adversity
- •It may take a while, but speaking God's truth to your family will not be without its effect in God's time

King: govern, provide, order "Go to Joseph" – Gen. 41:55



Joseph the Patriarch:

St. Joseph: provided security and presence. Made tough decisions to protect his family. Put self aside.



Lessons from 'the Josephs' as king

- A good provider doesn't always make a lot of money
- •Joseph's very name means "God will give increase"
- •We model God to our children whether we like it or not. The way we do that can be very ordinary.
- We also have to take responsibility to put God first in our family

St. Joseph: the light of the Christ Child in the everyday. Taking his family to the temple.




Lessons from 'the Josephs' as priest
